CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR BEEF CATTLE

1. All cattle must be entered in their correct age classes.
2. All cattle must be the legal property of the Exhibitor.
3. Bulls over 9 months of age must be ringed through the nose.
4. Females over 9 months of age must be led with a nose grip.
5. Calves shown on dams not to exceed 9 months of age on the day of the show.
6. All cattle must be tied by a halter and neck strap.
7. Cattle must be tied up, where directed by Stewards.
8. All cattle must be registered with the appropriate breed society.
9. All entries may be inspected for identification by an inspector or the respective Breed Society or representative of the Agricultural Society & registration papers to be available on request.
10. Advertising in the Judging ring is not permitted.

11. Camping on the ground will be permitted, by prior arrangement, for Cattle exhibitors arriving on Friday.
12. All Exhibitors are responsible for the safe control and supervision of their animals.
13. All exhibitors must work within the Occupational Health & Safety Legislation of the State of Victoria and ensure the safety of themselves, animals and persons attending with them during the show.
14. The Society reserves the right to substitute trophies, prize money and to alter or amend the program depending on entries received.
15. All exhibitors must either sign the show waiver or provide own Certificate of Currency for Public Liability the minimum value of 10 million dollars.

REGULATIONS FOR BEEF LEADER & BEEF CATTLE JUDGING

1. Parader competitions are conducted under the ASA regulations.
2. Competitors must be 15 years and under 25 years of age on the 1st May in the year of the State Final and must reside within Victoria.
3. First & Second Place getters are eligible to compete in the State Final.
4. Competitor must be attired in suitable clothing including solid shoes or boots.
5. Paraders must lead a heifer under 2 years as of the day of the show.
6. Judging competition is conducted under the ASA & VAS Ltd regulations.
7. Handlers 8 years & under must have adult supervision in handler class.
8. Handlers 15 year & over may be asked to swap animals if required.
